Tutoring Center

The Tutoring Center offers individual help with writing skills, including grammar, punctuation, mechanics, and spelling from faculty recommended, CRLA certified tutors. The Tutoring Center also offers specialized ESL tutoring for students enrolled in ESL classes to obtain assistance with conversation, assignments prompts, and grammar.

Appointments are one hour and must be made at least one day in advance. Each Fullerton College student is entitled to one appointment per class per week. Students involved with DSS or EOPS may be allowed additional hours. Saturdays are walk-in only.

The Writing Center offers one-on-one help with any stage of the writing process for any class at any level from English and ESL faculty as well as supervised, CRLA certified peer tutors. You can find all the writing tools you need in the Writing Center: computers, dictionaries, thesauruses, handbooks, and style manuals. Workshops are offered throughout the semester on various writing issues, such as personal statements, introductions and conclusions, paragraph development, and thesis statements.

Appointments are one half-hour and students may schedule up to two appointments per week. Students involved with DSS or EOPS may be allowed additional time. Walk-ins are also welcome.
